PITTCAT

PITTCat lists materials owned by the University of Pittsburgh libraries, including books, microforms, music, dissertations, government publications, and the periodical titles (journals, magazines, etc.). From the library's homepage (<http://www.library.pitt.edu>), click on the PITTCat link.

Subject Heading Search (Library of Congress Only)

Type one of the following:

STUDENT AID DIRECTORIES
SCHOLARSHIPS DIRECTORIES

Or, try one of these:

FOREIGN STUDY DIRECTORIES
MINORITIES SCHOLARSHIPS, FELLOWSHIPS, ETC.

Keyword Search

Keyword searching looks for the occurrences of a word(s) anywhere in PITTCat, and therefore may locate items not found by author, title, or subject searches. You may use as many words in a search as you like.

Type one of the following:

VETERANS FINANCIAL AID
GRANTS AND PSYCHOLOGY

These are only two examples of keyword searching; you may use any search you wish.

HINT: You may find more information in a general sourcebook on grants or scholarships, rather than attempt to find a source devoted specifically to your subject. Many general sources contain sections on loans or fellowships for specific purposes, but information on these sections will not show up in PITTCat.

ON THE WORLD WIDE WEB

You can find other scholarship and financial aid websites by doing a keyword search in your favorite search engine.

CAUTION! Beware of any website or group that wants you to pay in order to "guarantee" funding. Some companies may require payment so they can create a tailored profile to find scholarships that you qualify for, but it is up to you to apply.
