Academic Search Premier: Full-text scholarly and popular journal articles

Communications & Mass Media Complete: Full-text scholarly and popular articles

Expanded Academic ASAP: Full-text scholarly and popular journal articles

MLA International Bibliography: Scholarly and popular journal articles

National Newspapers: Full-text newspaper articles
