Go to <http://www.library.pitt.edu> and select "Find Articles." At the Zoom! screen, select a category or select one of the following databases:

Academic (Lexis-Nexis): Full-text newspaper articles

Expanded Academic ASAP: Scholarly and popular journal articles

National Newspapers: Full-text newspaper articles

CQ Researcher: In-depth essays on current issues

LegalTrac: Scholarly and popular journal articles on legal topics

PsycInfo: Scholarly journal articles on psychological issues

Sociological Abstracts: Scholarly journal articles on social issues
