Go to <http://www.library.pitt.edu> and select "Find Articles." At the Zoom! screen, select a science category or select one of the following databases:

Academic (Lexis-Nexis): Full-text newspaper articles
Academic OneFile: Scholarly and popular journal articles
Academic Search Premier: Scholarly and popular journal articles
Knovel: Quick overviews and definitions of science technology
Medline: Scholarly articles in the medical/science fields
Science Direct: Science, technology, and medical articles
Scopus: Scholarly articles in the medical/science fields
