### Borrowing East Asian Materials

In accordance with University Library System policy, all patrons must have a valid University of Pittsburgh ID card with proof of current registration or current employment in order to check out any library materials. Permission may be granted to borrow certain restricted materials. Materials can be checked out at the ground floor Lending Desk, located to your right as you enter Hillman Library. Reserved materials are kept at the Reserve Desk on the ground floor of Hillman Library.

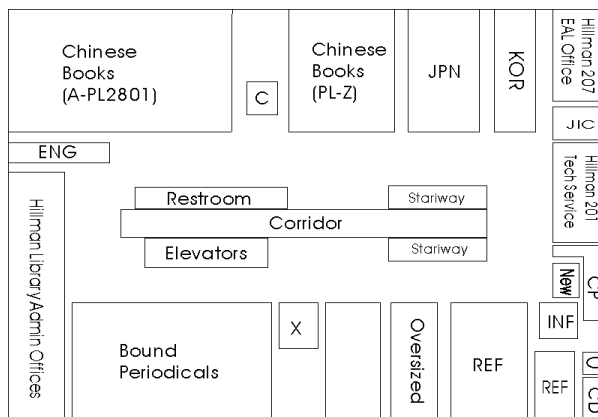
### Interlibrary Loan

ILL service allows you to borrow materials which are not available in the East Asian Library collection. You must be a student, faculty, or staff member at the University of Pittsburgh with a valid ID card. Your request must relate to and be in support of your course work, teaching, or research at the University of Pittsburgh. Most request take between 2 and 4 weeks, and there may be a charge for photocopies or rush orders. For assistance with using interlibrary loan,

consult with the East Asian Public Service Librarian, 207 Hillman Library.

### Parking and Access

Metered parking is available on Forbes Avenue and on Schenley Drive in front of Hillman Library. Public parking is also available in the Schenley Plaza parking lot in front of Hillman Library. Do not park in University of Pittsburgh lots unless you have a permit. The physically disabled-accessible entrance to Hillman Library is via the left ramp at the main entrance off Schenley Drive.



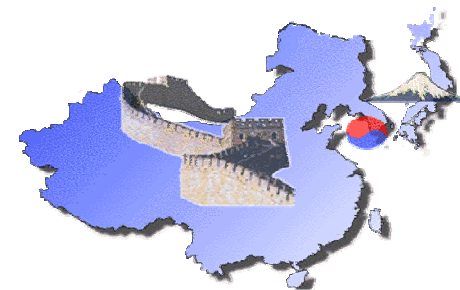

### **Introduction to the Collection**

The East Asian Library collection contains over 341,000 volumes of

Chinese, Japanese, Korean and Western language materials, including more than 1,900 periodical titles (over 45,000 bound volumes) published in the Mainland China, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Japan, and Korea.

The collection also holds more than 7,000 reels of microfilm, and over 25 current newspaper titles, including Asahi and Nikkei (Japanese), Zhongyang Ribao and Renmin Ribao (Chinese), and Dong a ilbo (Korean).

### **Reference Service**

EAL librarians and staff provide assistance with bibliographic searching, interlibrary loans, reference queries, and research. University of Pittsburgh patrons who desire in-depth assistance are encouraged to make an appointment with a librarian. Instructors are encouraged to schedule formal library instruction and tours for their classes. The reference desk at the East Asian Library is staffed by experienced librarians and information specialists ready to assist patrons from 11:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

The reference collection consists of dictionaries, almanacs, bibliographies, encyclopedias, directories, handbooks, yearbooks, manuals, and other materials. Electronic resources are also available.

### **Gateway Service Center**

The Gateway Service Center, which is administered by the East Asian Library of the University of Pittsburgh Library System, focuses on free delivery of full-text Chinese and Korean language academic publications to researchers via the Internet from Mainland China, Taiwan, Hong Kong, and Korea.

The Chinese Gateway Service delivers documents to everyone who cannot find the needed item in any U.S. libraries. However, the Korean Gateway Service (KDDS), currently, as our new announced service, delivers documents to Pitt faculty and students only. Please visit EAL website for more information.

### **Japan Information Center**

The Japan Information Center functions as an information gateway between the United States and Japan. It covers broad subject areas ranging from Japanese culture to Japanese government policies. The Center maintains a web site which provides
