The lab features 2 high end 64-bit Dell computers with Adobe Creative Suite software, allowing students to create and edit videos and graphic applications with their colleagues as well as a Korg keyboard to provide original and mixed audio files and music. A color printer,

poster printer, scanner, video and digital cameras, headphones, and other equipment for audio and video projects is also available. Equipment may circulate for three days with a valid Pitt Greensburg ID card.
